TICKET INFORMATION

SINGLE TICKETS: Single tickets for most events go on sale August 10, 2022 at 11:00 AM. They can be purchased in person at the Lied Center Ticket Office, via mail, phone or at liedcenter.org.

SEATING PRIORITY: Season ticket seating assignments are made on a first-come, first-served basis and by donor level (see "How Can I Get the Best Seats?").

GROUP SALES: Group discounts (for groups of 10 or more) are now available for most Lied Center-presented performances. Call 402.472.4734.

SPECIAL SEATING: Special seating for individuals with disabilities is available upon request.

ADMISSION: Regardless of age, every person must have a ticket for admission. Children under age 12 must be accompanied by an adult at all Lied events.

STUDENTS AND YOUTH: Anyone 18 years of age or younger receives a discount for most Lied Center-presented events. University of Nebraska– Lincoln students receive a discount for eligible events with a valid student I.D. (one ticket per I.D.), provided the student pays Fund A activity fees.
