There are a few changes to the top Friends of Lied membership levels and benefits, starting in January of 2023. 

HENRIETTA SOLWAY VISITS RED CLOUD, MCCOOK & KEARNEY

In our second Arts Across Nebraska tour of the season, Animal Engine Theater Company's *Henrietta Solway* visited the communities of Red Cloud, McCook, and Kearney on March 1-3, 2023. Henrietta Solway, a new play commissioned by the National Willa Cather Center, combines the short fiction and serialized novels of Pulitzer Prize-winning author and Nebraskan Willa Cather into one epic story.

In Red Cloud, the show played a sold out student matinee at the Red Cloud Opera House, the very stage Cather wrote about in works featured in the script, as well as an evening performance, to enthusiastic crowds. Artistic Director and actor Karim Muasher also led an acting workshop for one-act play production participants from Red Cloud High School and the entire company joined for a post-show Q&A at the public performance. At our second stop in McCook, the company also performed a student matinee for area youth, following up with a Q&A about the production and life as theatre artists. The evening performance played to a full main floor at the Fox Theater and surveys had audiences raving about the imaginative dialogue and physicality of the piece. In Kearney, the Merryman Performing Arts Center hosted two matinee performances for students and members of the public. These performances featured an informative and lively pre-talk with Cather scholars Drs. Charles Peek and Steve Shively. Peek and Shively joined the cast for more conversation with the audience post-show.

Friends of Lied education committee chair and members Dee Cummins, Nancy Brosz, Julie Neidfeldt, and Paulette Stefka facilitated receptions at the Red Cloud and McCook public performances, sharing coffee, cookies, chocolates, and information about Friends of Lied with community members. It was wonderful to have Friends supporting us on the road and friend-raising in local communities.

Henrietta Solway was a perfect addition to the 25th season of Arts Across Nebraska, presenting a professional production sharing Nebraska stories with audiences spanning over 500 miles of the state! Thank you to the Friends of Lied for making this experience possible.

THIS MAY, AMERICAN BALLET THEATRE RETURNS TO LINCOLN!

America's National Ballet Company has a close relationship with the Lied Center, including the unforgettable collaboration with the St. Louis Symphony in 2018 that brought the masterpiece *Firebird* to the Lied stage starring Misty Copeland. In 2021, ABT chose the Lied Center to host the kickoff of their historic ABT Across America tour, drawing more than 6,000 people to Lincoln's Pioneers Park to experience an evening of ballet under the stars. From there the tour moved on to iconic venues including Chicago's Millennium Park and New York's Rockefeller Center, but as then-ABT Executive Director Kara Barnett put it, "Lincoln, Nebraska has become a homeaway-from-home for American Ballet Theatre."
